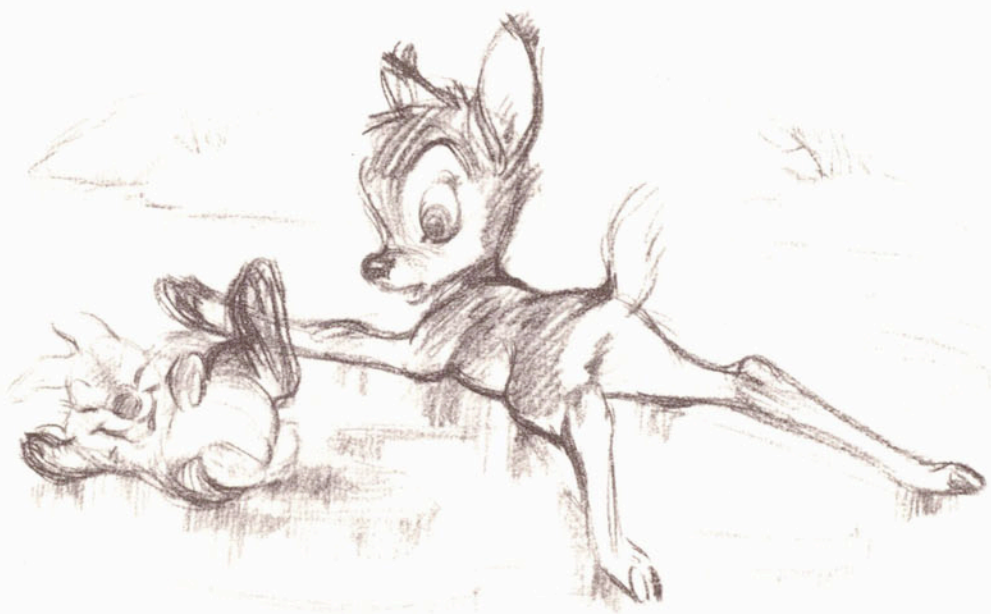

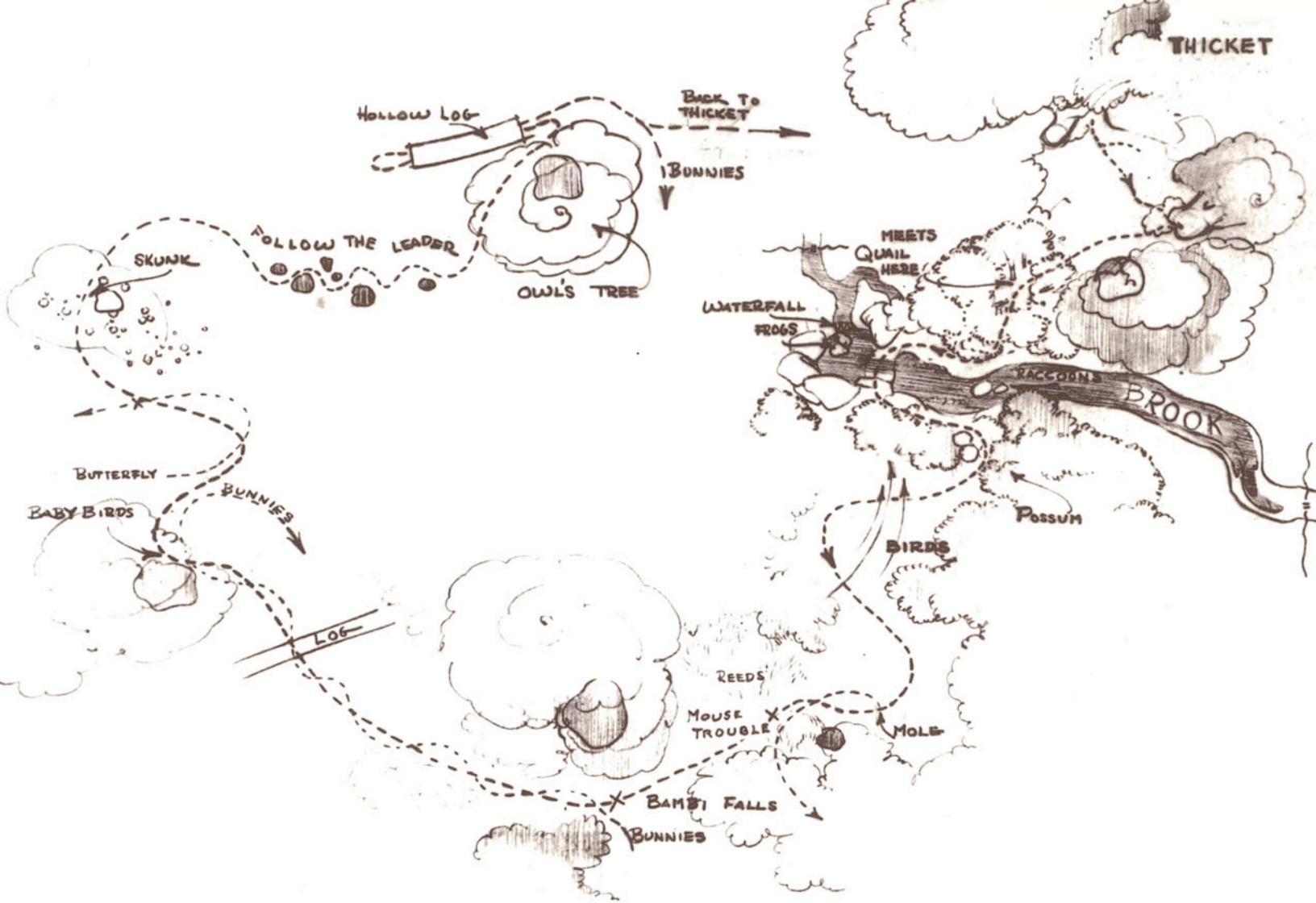

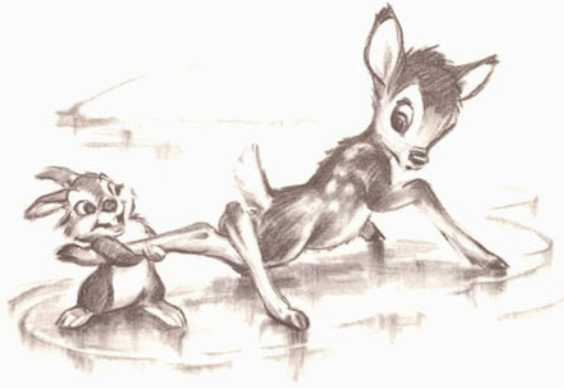

This sketchbook is living proof of that.

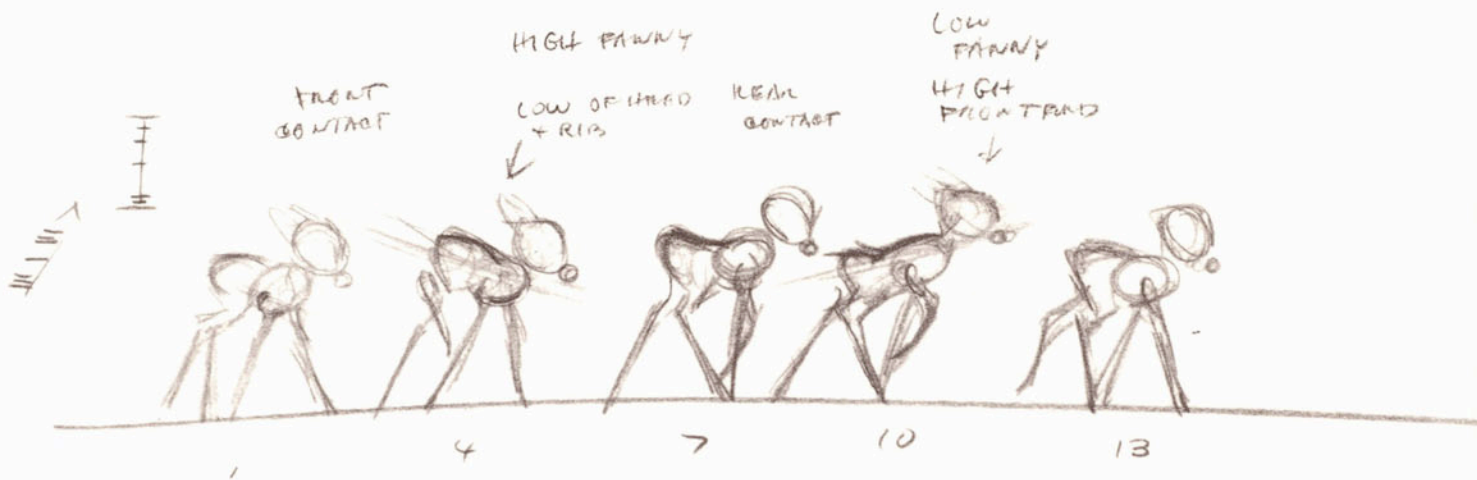

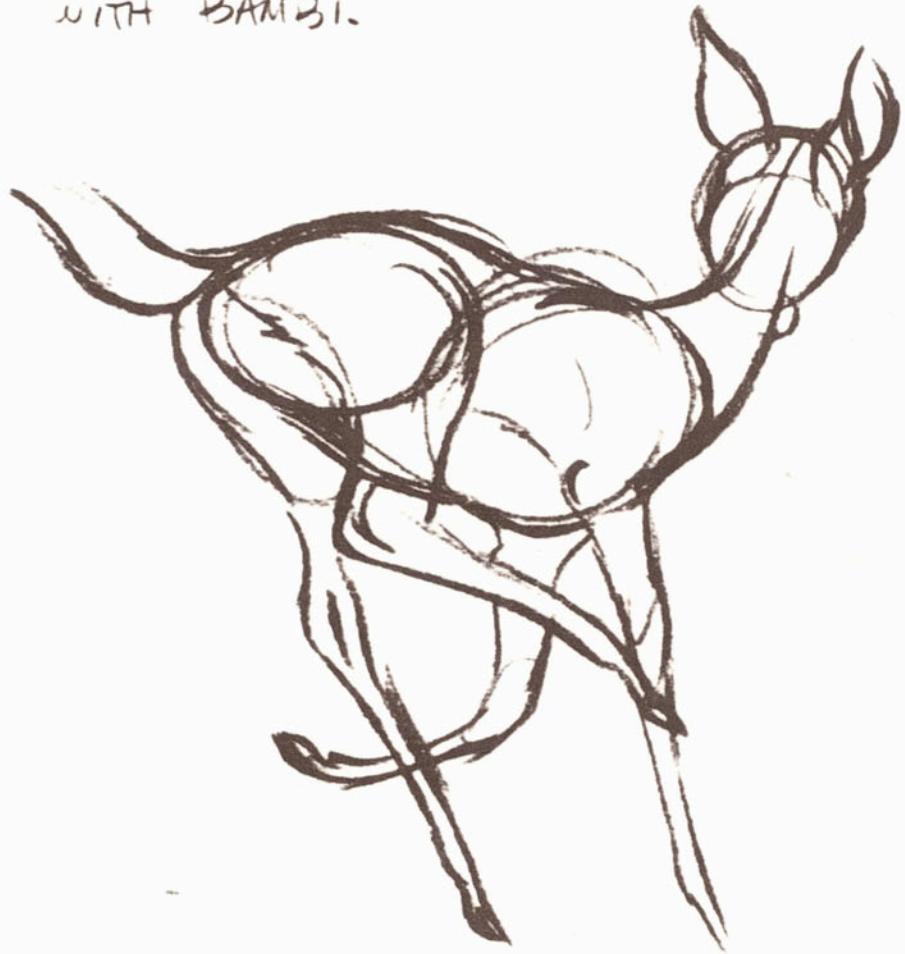








CONSTRUCTION OF

 WITH BAMBI.

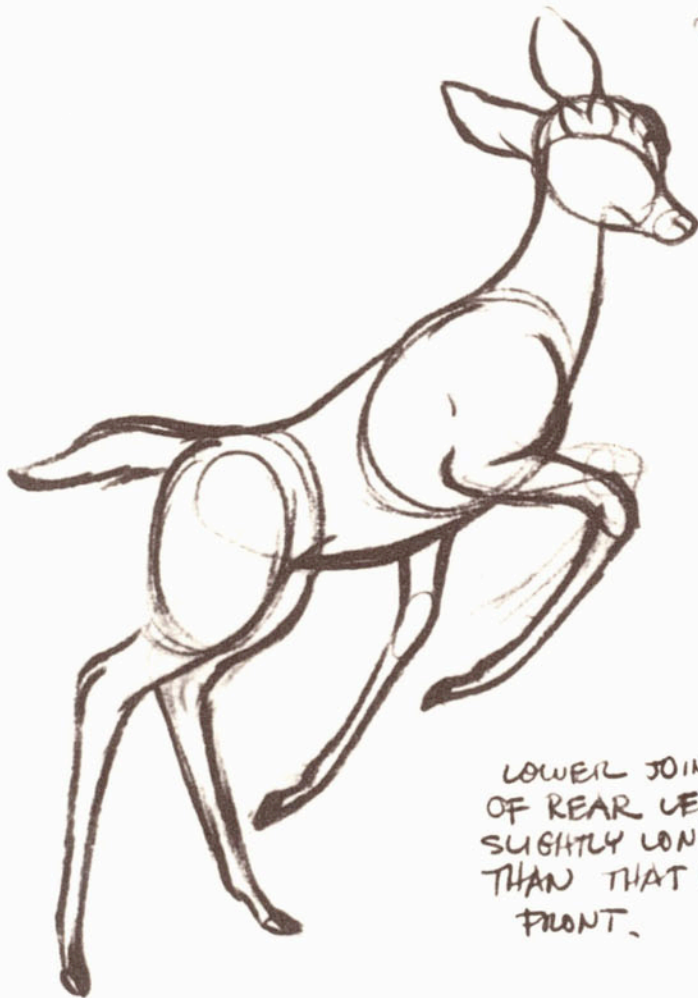




LENGTH
